If you are new to Competitive Trail Riding, we invite you to come and ride. Don't let the idea of "Competition" keep you away either. Saturday morning will consist of a clinic, learning about competitive trail riding and practicing how to use GPS for navigation down the trails. A Leisure Division ride will be held the same day after a break for lunch. Enter just the Clinic, just the Leisure ride, or enter both and get a discount on the Leisure ride entry.

A Competitive Trail Ride is NOT A RACE. It is a timed and measured distance-riding event. Horses of all breeds, including mules, are invited to compete in NATRC. You will follow marked trails using GPS and a printed map with specified minimum and maximum riding times. You and your horse will be observed over the course of the ride by an experienced Leisure Division (LeD) judge. You will be judged on the way you handle and care for your horse and how you negotiate trail conditions such as steep ascents and descents, and natural trail obstacles. Your horse will be judged on condition and capability to continue. It is strongly recommended that horses be shod due to the nature of the terrain. Any type of boot is allowed.

GENERAL INFO

This ride is sanctioned by North American Trail Ride Conference and will be governed by the rules thereof. The rule book is available online at http://www.natrc.org under Resources tab.

Lunch will be in camp after the clinic and prior to the start of the LeD ride. A Sandwich Bar will be provided by Ride Management for all Clinic attendees, those entered in the Leisure Division ride, and volunteers.

AWARDS: Awards will be presented as soon as scores can be tabulated. Awards will be given to first through sixth place team of each class. All horses/mules and riders are encouraged to remain for the awards presentation.

HOOF BOOTS: There are no shoeing restrictions. All types of hoof boots that provide sole protection are allowed.

REGISTRATION PAPERS: This event is open to all horses, mules, and ponies and does NOT REQUIRE Registration Papers to enter or participate. Management STRONGLY requests that any horse, mule, or pony that is registered provide a copy of the Registration Papers with the entry so NATRC can track participation by breed.

CAMP: Plan to arrive at camp on Saturday morning by 8:00 am to register for the clinic. We will be parking in the equestrian staging area with horse water, manure bins and porta potties available. Open fires, <u>loose</u> dogs or other pets are FORBIDDEN. **No smoking will be permitted on the trail or in camp** (if you must smoke, it must be inside a private vehicle). Anyone caught smoking on trail will be disqualified and asked to leave. Dogs must be on a leash.

WHAT TO BRING - All food for you and your horse. MANURE must be **picked up**. Saddle, bridle, pads, grooming equipment, buckets, hay nets and anything you need for your horse. Bring tools to clean around your stabling area. Also, bring your personal sun protection lotion, sunglasses, water bottles, and folding chair (for briefing), wristwatch with sweep second hand, etc.

VOLUNTEERS: Yes, we can always use volunteers!

ENTRIES: Entries must be received by Tuesday, October 1, 2024. Minimum deposit is \$25.00. The deposit is non-refundable.

Late Arrivals: Please call ahead if you will be arriving after 8:00 am for the Clinic, or after 11:00 am for the LeD Ride.

Emergency Phone Number: 760-315-7479 and 760-789-0007. Cell phone coverage in camp and on most trails is usually available.

LEISURE DIVISION – Is a one-day ride. Horses, mules, and ponies must be at least 48 months of age. Mileage will be between 8-12 miles, usually about 10 miles with a speed of 3 to 4.5 mph, usually about 3.5 mph. Horse and rider compete as a team and their combined score is used to determine placing recognition.

CLASSES (3)

EXPERIENCED—Anyone who is a judge, has more than 250 points in horsemanship, won a National Championship or obtained 1500 miles in competition must compete in Experienced. Any Rider (Adult or Junior) may compete in this class if they choose.

ADULT – Riders 18 or older. Intended for riders new to the sport. More experienced riders should consider entering the Experienced class.

JUNIOR -- Ages 8 through 17. If 17 on January 1 of the current year, the entrant will ride as a Junior for the remainder of the year. Juniors may choose to compete in either the Experienced or Adult classes. Juniors must wear ASTM/SEI or other approved EQUESTRIAN riding helmet while mounted.

SCHEDULE OF EVENTS:

SATURDAY October 5, 2024:

- **CLINIC CHECK-IN** will begin about 8:00 am. Riders will be provided with a packet that includes information about the Leisure Division (LeD), NATRC, a map and rider number.
- **CLINIC DISCUSSIONS** will begin about 8:30 am.
- LED ONLY CHECK-IN will begin at 11:00 am.
- SANDWICH BAR LUNCH (Included) will begin at 11:30 am.
- **LED BRIEFING** Management will provide a detailed briefing about the LeD competition and the trails. Bring your map and a pen for writing notes.
- RIDER TEAM CHECK-IN (WITH HORSE) will begin at 1 pm, with the ride beginning shortly after all are checked in.
- AWARDS will be presented as quickly as they are tabulated.



DIRECTIONS TO CAMP DAY USE STAGING AREA

I-5 Southbound: Take I-5 South to Hwy 56. Go EAST on Hwy 56 for 6.6 miles to Black Mountain Rd exit (Exit 1). Turn RIGHT onto Black Mountain Rd. to Mercy Rd. Turn RIGHT into the Day Use Area and follow signs to the Equestrian Staging Area. Day Use Fees will be paid by Ride Management, so you can skip the fee kiosk.

I-15 Northbound: Take I-15 North to the Mercy Rd/Scripps Poway Parkway exit. Turn LEFT at the bottom of the off-ramp and go WEST on Mercy Rd.

Or I-15 Southbound: Take Interstate 15 South to the Mercy Rd/Scripps Poway Parkway exit. Turn RIGHT at the bottom of the off-ramp and go WEST on Mercy Rd.

Both I-15 - At Mercy Rd: Cross the street into the Day Use Area and follow signs to the Equestrian Staging Area.

Everyone - Day Use Fees will be paid by Ride Management, so you can skip the fee kiosk.
